End of the Year Benchmark Windows

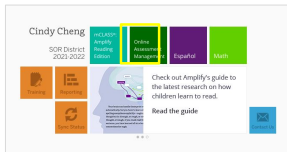

Steps to Assign Online Measures

1. Login to mCLASS Home
2. Click on the green Online Assessment Management tile
3. Once inside Online Assessment Management:
 - a. Select your class from the drop down menu
 - b. Assign assessments to your whole class by using the class assign menu on the left hand side of the screen, or assign assessments to individual students by selecting the options underneath the students name
 - c. Selections save automatically
4. Use the QR for a recorded walk through of the process

Screening Instrument Requirements

- Must have established validity and reliability and standards
- Must also include distinct indicators identifying students as either not at risk or at risk for dyslexia or reading difficulties
- Must also provide standardized directions for administration as well as clear guidance for the administrator regarding scoring and interpretation of indicators/results.
- Must include adequate training for educators on how to administer the instrument and interpret results


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

Risk Indicator for Spanish Assessments


The risk indicator flag is a feature in mCLASS reports for educators to be able to see the students whose assessment results suggest they might be at additional risk for reading difficulties, including difficulty related to dyslexia.

Students who are identified as "at risk" based on certain criteria have the Risk Indicator  displayed to the right of their name on the Benchmark Class Summary report after the most recent Benchmark assessment and on the Benchmark Class Summary Time of Year (TOY) report.



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

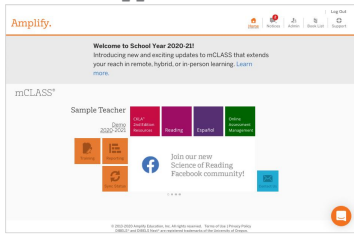
