Students' progress will be tracked on each skill and - after an appropriate number of data points are collected - it will flag whether the student is on- or off-track for their target skill(s).

What is the headline update?

- New RFS 23 Update! Revised Spelling Español cutpoints, allowing for a new 'well below benchmark' level
- Having two cutpoints creates three performance levels: red (well below), yellow (below), and green (meeting benchmark) in Spelling Español
- It will provide educators with a more precise interpretation of results to support students.
- Historical data will be updated in Classroom Reports and Admin Reports to reflect the changes (e.g. a student might have been green previously, now with a different cutpoint might be yellow)..
